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Safety Tips

- Position on a flat, stable surface.
- A service agent/qualified technician should carry out installation and any repairs if required. Do not remove any components on this product.
- Consult Local and National Standards to comply with the following:
 - Health and Safety at Work Legislation
 - BS EN Codes of Practice
 - Fire Precautions
 - IEE Wiring Regulations
 - Building Regulations
- **Warning! Hot surface!** Always wear safety gloves when placing or removing foods.



- DO NOT immerse the appliance in water, or use jet/pressure washers to clean the appliance.
- DO NOT overfill the appliance. Keep the water level below the 'Max' level.
- DO NOT allow the water level to drop below the 'Min' level during operation.
- DO NOT move the appliance when it contains hot liquid.
- Do not use the appliance for anything other than its intended use.
- Always switch off and disconnect the power supply to the appliance when not in use.
- Not suitable for outdoor use.
- Keep all packaging away from children. Dispose of the packaging in accordance to the regulations of local authorities.
- If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by a Buffalo agent or a recommended qualified technician in order to avoid a hazard.



- This appliance must only be used in accordance with these instructions and by persons competent to do so.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning the use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

Should you find any damage as a result of transit, please contact your Buffalo dealer immediately.


Installation

- Remove the appliance from the packaging. Make sure that all protective plastic film and coatings are thoroughly removed from all surfaces.
- 2. Maintain a distance of 20cm (7 inches) between the unit and walls or other objects for ventilation.



Note: Before using the appliance for the first time, clean the shelves and interior with soapy water.

- 3. Set the brakes on the castors to keep the appliance in position.
- 4. Check to make sure the drainage tap at the upper end of the drainage hose is already closed.





Operation


Storing Food

To get the best results from your Buffalo appliance, follow these instructions:

- The appliance is designed for keeping food warm only, not for cooking. Always pre-cook the food.
- Only store foodstuffs in the appliance when it has reached the correct operating temperature.
- Use the spacer bars provided to fill any gaps (they are not required to support each GN pans).
- Always cover the pan with lid when not in use.

Raise/Lower the glass cover

- To raise the glass cover, unlock the buckles at two sides first. The glass cover will rise automatically. Then turn the screws clockwise to tighten.
- To lower the glass cover, loosen the screws first. Then press down the glass cover on both ends simultaneously. Finally lock the buckles in place.





Note: Do not place heavy objects (e.g., stacked plates) on the glass cover or folding shelves. Use the fixed shelves instead.

Filling the water tank

 Fill the tank with water to a level between the 'Min' and 'Max' marks on the inside of the tank.




Note: Never use the appliance without water in the tank, or the food will burn and the appliance will overheat and may get damaged.

Insert the 1/1 GN pans (not supplied) into the water tank.


Control panel

The control panel is located at the rear of the appliance.





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Turn On

- 1. Ensure the power switch is set to [**0**] and turn on at the socket.
- 2. Switch on the Power [I].

Illumination

Press the light button $\fill \fill \fill$

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Adjusting the Temperature

- Press SET button. The set temperature is displayed.
- 2. Press up button ≜ or down button ₹ to change the set temperature.
- 3. Press **SET** button to exit.
- 4. When the set temperature is reached, the heating indicator light goes out.
- 5. The appliance is now ready for food to be put inside and kept warm.

Maintaining Water Levels

- 1. The appliance will beep when the water level is too low. Switch off the Power [**0**].
- Remove the GN pans while wearing safety gloves. Then add water carefully to prevent hot water splashing out.

Always keep the water level between the 'Min' and 'Max' marks on the inside of the tank during operation.

Damage to the heating element can occur if the tank boils dry and the element may have to be replaced. This is not covered by the Buffalo warranty.

Thermal Cut-Out Reset

- This appliance is fitted with a Thermal Cut-Out safety feature. Should the temperature exceed safe levels the appliance will automatically cut nower
- Allow the appliance to cool for 30-45 minutes.

Cleaning, Care & Maintenance



Switch off and disconnect the appliance from the power supply. Then allow to cool down before cleaning and maintenance.

- Wipe down the exterior of the appliance with a damp cloth..
- Remove the GN pans and clean with warm, soapy water and a damp cloth.
- Open the drainage tap to empty the water tank. Then close the tap.
- Clean the interior of the appliance as often as possible.
- Do not use abrasive cleaning agents. These can leave harmful residues.
- · Always wipe dry after cleaning.

Replacing the Lamp

Call your Polar dealer or a qualified electrician. The Lamp Assembly is available to purchase as a spare part.

Electrical Wiring

This appliance is supplied with a 3 pin, moulded, BS1363 plug and lead, with a 13 amp fuse as standard.

The plug is to be connected to a suitable mains socket.

This appliance is wired as follows:

- · Live wire (coloured brown) to terminal marked L
- · Neutral wire (coloured blue) to terminal marked N
- Earth wire (coloured green/yellow) to terminal marked E

This appliance must be earthed.



If in doubt consult a qualified electrician.

Electrical isolation points must be kept clear of any obstructions. In the event of any emergency disconnection being required they must be readily accessible.
